A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND PERFORM A CERTAIN AGREEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEARCY, TO-WIT:

WHEREAS, the City of Searcy has been presented a certain agreement associated with the operations of the City of Searcy or that have an impact upon the residents of the City of Searcy, namely an agreement with:

White County Historical Society - Pioneer Village

(the “Agreement”) a copy of which has been submitted to the Searcy City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Searcy wishes to approve the execution of, ratify the terms of and perform under the conditions contained in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Searcy, Arkansas, to-wit:

Section 1. That the Searcy City Council approves and ratifies the terms, conditions and obligations of the Agreement.

Section 2. That the Searcy City Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and City Clerk to execute, and perform under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to take all actions determined to be necessary, in the sole and exclusive determination of the Mayor, in the performance of all obligations, duties and responsibilities associated with the Agreement.

USE AGREEMENT
Between the CITY OF SEARCY and the
WHITE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

This use agreement made and entered into between the CITY OF SEARCY and the WHITE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

The City of Searcy has given permission for the White County Historical Society to locate Pioneer Village within the northern most section of the City property located on Higginson Street. Pioneer Village consists of a number of historical buildings, farm implements, tools, clothing and other antiques.

This agreement is entered into for the purpose of preserving and promoting the historical heritage of our community and surrounding areas. Pioneer Village is open to the public and used to educate and entertain all age groups through a number of functions held throughout the year.

The White County Historical Society is responsible for maintaining the historical buildings to insure their safe use by the public.

The City of Searcy is responsible for maintaining the grounds and city owned property located within Pioneer Village.

The terms of this use agreement will be reviewed and renewed annually by the Searcy City Council, unless written notice of agreement termination is given by either party.
