CHAPTER 8 CEMETERIES

Sec. 8-1. Opening Grave Site; Restrictions.

Any person who shall assume the responsibilities of opening a grave site in Oak Grove Cemetery shall be required to close the grave in accordance with good business practice, and not later than ten (10) days from the opening of the grave; and such person, firm or corporation shall be required to dispose of and remove from the cemetery all excess dirt, rocks and debris. (Ord. No. 498, § 1, 67)

Sec. 8-2. Operation of Vehicles.

All vehicles driven or brought into, through, within or out of Oak Grove Cemetery shall be kept within the existing roadways and shall not be permitted to cross any cemetery property, grave plot or grave marker outside the roadway. For purposes of this section a vehicle is defined as any automobile, truck backhoe, tractor or any other motor driven machine. (Ord. No. 498, § 2, 67)

Sec. 8-3. Damage to Property.

Mutilation, defacement or damage to any of the cemetery property, grave sites or markers, whether intentional or otherwise, is prohibited.

In addition to other penalties provided herein, any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter may be prohibited from using the cemetery facilities by action of a majority of the City Council. (Ord. No. 498, §§ 3, 4, 67)

Sec. 8-4. Penalty for Violations.

Any person who shall violate any of the provision of the chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be punished by a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and, in addition, may be required to make restitution for any damage which may have been done by the wrongful or negligent act of said person and may be specifically required to restore the damage to property. (Ord. No. 498, § 5, 67)
