

Searcy City Council – Special Session
December 14, 2020 11:00 a.m.
Minutes

Mayor Kyle Osborne called to order a Special Session of the Searcy City Council. Council member Dale Brewer gave the Invocation, with the Pledge of Allegiance following, led by Rodger Cargile. City Clerk/Treasurer Jerry Morris called the roll with the following Council members answering “present”: Logan Cothorn, Mary Ann Arnett, Rodger Cargile, Tonia Hale, Don Raney, Dale Brewer and Mike Chalenburg. Also present was City Attorney Buck Gibson.

Item (3) was a resolution declaring certain real property located at 606 Eastwood Drive a nuisance, directing the removal of the improvements constituting the nuisance, and for other purposes. This resolution was also for the correction and repeal of Resolution 2020-37 adopted at the regular December 8, 2020 Council meeting. The correction was for identifying the correct owners of the property. Mr. Gibson read the resolution in full. A motion was then made by Mr. Raney, seconded by Mrs. Arnett, to adopt the resolution. The resolution passed with the following voting “yes”: Arnett, Cargile, Hale, Raney, Brewer, Chalenburg, and Cothorn. **Resolution 2020-38**
